The Sophia Way's 2022 fall fundraiser, **Sheltering**, has been reimagined as a community event hosted by community members instead of a single luncheon, creating the opportunity for intimate engagement. There will be an opening and closing event, bookending the community event.

Sheltering

We invite our community to host a personal gathering – inviting friends, family, neighbors – and share their passion for supporting women experiencing homelessness. Each host personalizes their event, choosing the location, the time, food, and the guests.

The Sophia Way will support the host with communication and marketing material. In addition, one or two staff and board members will be present at your event to talk about the organization's mission and programs, and respond to questions.
