It is estimated that 20-40% of individuals experiencing homelessness identify as part of the LGBTQIA+ community, despite only comprising about 5-10% of the general population. This population faces numerous challenges, including mental health issues, abuse, discrimination, racism, and xenophobia, further complicated by intersecting identities.

Recognizing these unique struggles, The Sophia Way is dedicated to supporting female-identifying individuals experiencing homelessness in an equitable manner. Our shelters provide resources for mental and physical healthcare, inclusive hygiene products, and harm reduction supplies. We offer ongoing staff training in cultural humility, trauma-informed care, and diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI). The Sophia Way is committed to continuously enhancing our services to create a safe and supportive environment, helping all female-identifying individuals attain and maintain permanent housing.
